Board of Directors nominations: Each year some members of our Board of Directors end their term, and two or three new members join. This transition takes place July 1 each year, following the same schedule as other church committees and boards. Members of the congregation are invited to nominate people for the Board of Directors on the back of the green Connection Cards **during the month of March**. All names will be forwarded to the Nominating Committee for consideration; a slate of nominees for open positions will then be presented to the **May 22nd Church Conference** for a vote.

Update on our 2022 stewardship campaign: First, many thanks to all for your generosity and support! We have reached 94.6% of our goal. In dollars, we're \$43,000 short of our \$800,000 pledge target. As we come to the end of the first quarter of 2022, we are experiencing higher than anticipated monthly expenses despite ongoing efforts to conserve. Fully reopening from Covid will bring additional costs. Higher expenses coupled with lower pledge revenue may force us to cut the budget. Before we resort to that, we wanted to reach out to everyone once more and ask for your help. Please prayerfully consider pledging or increasing your pledge **by April 10**. Finance Committee will then meet to make recommendations to bring the budget into balance. Pledge cards are available on the Welcome Table in the Narthex.
